# Summer 2018 - Enrichment Class Descriptions

## **Crafty Kids** (crafts)

Children in this fun class learn a new crafting technique every week! Activities will include sewing, painting, scrapbooking, friendship bracelets, paper crafting, and more! Crafters will bring home their project each week.

## **Fine Motor Fun** (fine motor skills)

Children show significant improvement in their fine motor skills, which are fundamental to school readiness, when given greater exposure and practice in new and exciting fine motor activities. This class helps children to strengthen hand muscles and hand control, to distinguish and strengthen a dominant hand, and to gain confidence in fine motor skills.

## **Español** (beginning spanish)

Exposing young children to the language and cultures of others is extremely valuable and can result in enhanced academic achievement in reading, math and social studies. This class will include whole and small group activities to teach Spanish vocabulary and language skills.

## **Woodworking in the Garden** (outdoors)

This class will combine two hobbies: Building & Gardening! Each carpenter will build, stain and plant his/her own planter box to take home, in addition to learning about how to care for our school garden. Children will come away with a basic knowledge of safety, garden care & maintenance and a great sense of accomplishment!

## **Social Club** (social skills)

Children learn to read social cues, discover ways to appropriately express their own needs, try on different emotions and begin to feel the benefit of positive communication with others. Taught with a fun approach, this class provides common social situations to strengthen your child's social skills.

## **Little Chef/Tiny Chef** (cooking)

Does your child like to help in the kitchen? Little Chefs will assist our resident culinary teacher in making a variety of dishes that are easy, tasty, colorful, and kid-friendly! Recipes include main dishes, finger foods, beverages, and desserts! Some unfamiliar foods will be introduced, so this class is great for those with picky palates...

## **Safari Kids** (animals)

Join us on a Safari this summer! Each week students will travel to a new country and learn about animals native to the region. Through literature, geography, art and imagination students will discover new facts about a specific animals.

## **Little Engineers** (STEM curriculum)

A fun and informative class, focused on the "E" in STEM... this class will introduce children to the field of engineering through literature and hands-on structure building such as railroads, waterways, skyscrapers and robots. By experimenting, analyzing, observing and building, students will be encouraged to make sense of abstract concepts and think outside the box.

## **Little Movers & Shakers** (music)

Come dance and sing your way through a fun half-hour with our ever-popular Music Teacher, Mr. Garixe! He will present songs and music for preschoolers to strengthen their musical ears and gross motor skills.

Also available: Parent/Toddler Music will be held once a week, ages 18mos+

## **Yoga**

Start their day off will balance, peace and sun salutations. Students will go on a yoga adventure using their imaginations to explore a variety of poses. Children will practice breathing techniques and explore creative movement.

## **Little Scholars** (kinder prep)

Designed for students who have completed Pre-K, this class will support and enhance the foundational skills that will boost confidence and success in Kindergarten. This class will prevent the summer slump and keep students academically engaged throughout the summer. 1:5 teacher:student ratio.

## **Magical Math** (math concepts)

A math program designed in two parts for children of varying developmental levels. Activities will include whole and small group activities, technology, art, fine motor and gross motor games. The class is designed to build a strong foundation of counting, number recognition, and patterning. Activities may include: graphing, measurement, and positional vocabulary.

## **Little Scientist** (science)

Your Little Scientist will have a blast as they experience the magical world of science! In addition to vocabulary such as *experiment*, *hypothesis*, *procedure* and *result*, they will conduct hands-on experiments and activities to learn the process of investigation, learn how to ask scientific questions, make careful observations to explain results and how to communicate what happens in experiments to others.

## **Read/Write to the Core** (literacy)

Keep up the reading, writing and math skills that were planted over the past year, and continue to build! This small class is taught by credentialed Reading Specialist Mrs. Jones, includes research-based activities and lessons that build, promote and encourage the growth of the whole child. Students in the RTTC program during 2017/18 will have first priority to enroll in the summer. For children who have completed PreK.

## **Little Artists** (art)

Enrich your child's life—and natural sense of discovery—through open-ended art! Artists will use imagination to create, process and use assorted materials. The art will be hands-on and reflect each individual's own work. Students will present their work to the class, building communication, language & social skills.

## **Successful Little Athletes** (sports)

Successful Little Athletes was designed and is taught by Marti May M.A., M.S. since 1991. Coach Marti uses her experience as a child counselor and her training in physical education to focus on building confidence and large motor skills. Participants will use sport as a medium for enhancing confidence, coordination and competency.

## **Storybook Ballet** (dance)

Stretch your imaginations and your toes! This class combines ballet and classic literature. Each week students will focus on a different fairy tale that has been turned into a ballet. Your child will use literature, imagery, music and ribbons to discover self expression through dance.

## **Bee Bots/Tiny Coder** (coding and robotics)

Tiny Coders will inspire little learners to be big thinkers. In this class we will work in small groups to program our robot. Linking interchangeable directional segments children will send Code-a-Pillar on a new adventure each week.

## **CORE Athletics** (sports)

CORE is a youth sports academy devoted to using sports to positively impact children's lives. At CORE, children fine-tune their sport skills in a fun and exciting atmosphere, while being exposed to important life lessons. With a low 1:4 coach to student ratio, CORE kids gain skills and progress quickly.
